


Training your pet

Most pets will learn to use a pet door almost at once but there are a few which may be a bit nervous at first. The following tips will help your pet take full advantage of the outdoor freedom and indoor comfort:

- The most important rule is to be patient with your pet. Let your animal work out for itself that it can go in and out of doors. Don't force them through the flap or they may become frightened.
- Many pet owners install pet doors when they move house. If this applies to you, make sure your pet is familiar with their surroundings before you fit the pet door - pets can develop long lasting fears in unfamiliar surroundings.
- Once you have installed your pet door leave it propped open. You can do this by using a long strip of masking tape - fixing one end of the tape to the flap and the other to the surface above. Let your pet become familiar with it and go in and out freely.
- Establish a motive for your pet to use the door. The obvious one is food. First feed the pet near your door, inside and then near the door outside. Repeat as often as you need to. It is not a good idea to use the lock for your pet door until your pet is thoroughly familiar with using the door.

For many pet owners there is a big dilemma with what to do with their pets whilst out and about. For instance keeping a pet inside during the day may seem unfair as it denies them their freedom and exercise, whereas locking them out cuts them off from their food, sleeping area and other home comforts. Manual 4 Way locking Deluxe Cat Flap that allows you to control your cat's access from in only, out only, opened & locked. Available in white & wood grain effect.

Magnetic 4 Way Locking Deluxe Cat Flap is operated by a magnetic collar key to help keep out strays. Available in white & wood grain effect.



Aluminium Pet Door has a strong aluminium frame that is available in four different sizes with a tinted flexible flap and a locking security barrier to keep your pet either inside or outside as required. Available in white.



Original 2 Way Pet Door gives your pet full access in and out of your home, also features an internal closing panel if needed. Available in small medium and large sizes to suit different breeds. Available in silver, brown & white.

Microchip Smart Flap activated by your cat's own microchip, it has a night mode and operates on mains power, although it will switch to battery should the power go down. Allows fast cat access and can be programmed to scan up to 31 cats. Available in white.



Deluxe Patio Panel Pet Door locks into an existing glass door frame with no additional cutting required. With a reversible lock for either left or right opening doors, it has a heavy duty aluminium frame. Available in small, medium and large.

To cut holes in toughened glass or double glazed units please consult a glazier.

If fitting a 'Magnetic' model into double glazed glass, a plastic spacer must be used. Please consult a glazier.

'Magnetic' cat flaps will not work if installed directly into a surface directly containing metal. The unit must be isolated from these materials in a wooden frame. Full details are in the user guide.

These products will not prevent unwanted animals or people including children from passing through the pet door.
